VA REQUIREMENTS - 3M's

- ★ **MILITARY SERVICE:** Minimum 90 days active duty, with at least one day during wartime, and an honorable discharge.
- ★ **MEDICAL NEEDS:** Non service-connected disability which requires assistance with activities of daily living.
- ★ **MONEY (Financial Limitations):** Limited resources in relation to medical expenses.
